5. Read the article:
"An Anticorruption Plea in Kenya: 'Please, Just Steal a Little'" and write on a three paragraph summary [introduction-body-conclusion] explaining the current condition of the Kenyan Government. You must cite evidence from the article in order to get any credit for this assignment. \$6

6. Journal
Choose a government, then: write a series of journal entries (5) as if you were a student living in the government of one of the 3 countries. Describe your thoughts and feelings of the events that are occurring around you. Describe some of the possibilities. Maybe you are 18 and can vote! (At least 3 sentences per entry). \$6

7. Interview
Conduct an interview with one of the people we have discussed. (F.W. DeKlerk, Mandela, or the leaders from the most recent packet Jomo Kenyatta and Abubakar Tafewa Balewa) Include thought-provoking questions and the person's responses. Questions need to be about GOVERNMENT. At least 5 questions and answers. \$6

8. Sketch an Organizer
Create an organizer about ALL 3 of the governments: Kenya, Nigeria, and South Africa. The organizer should show how they are similar and how they are different. You need to have at least 6 bubbles total with 10 facts/comparisons. \$6
